- 1. Emergency Motel Assistance Program:** *Very short-term emergency local motel assistance is available for literally homeless individuals and families.*

- 2. Beaver County On-Call:** *In the event of a disaster in which the Red Cross has provided short term motel stays to victims, Beaver County On-Call enlists the assistance of local churches, organizations and individuals to provide additional motel assistance while permanent housing is secured.*

- 3. St Vincent De Paul Basic Needs Assistance:** *Limited financial assistance is available to low-income county residents, based on an intake and needs assessment.*

Beaver County Faith-Based Assistance:** *Limited assistance for emergency food, furniture, Greyhound bus transportation, identification, rent and utilities is available to low-income county residents from faith-based churches and groups upon verification that traditional funding streams have been exhausted.*

- 5. Patterson Grant Bus Ticket Program:** *Limited number of BCTA and PAT bus tickets are available for low-income county residents for whom lack of safe, affordable transportation is a barrier to self-sufficiency.*
