## BC CAN Announces Active Shooter Training

Beaver County CAN, in collaboration with the Pennsylvania LINK to Aging and Disabilities Resources of Allegheny, Beaver, Fayette, Greene, and Washington Counties, will offer an **Active Shooter Training**. Presenters will include The Center Township Police, and The Pittsburgh Office of Homeland Security.

**Date:** November 1, 2018 (Thursday)  
**Location:** The Center at the Mall, in the Beaver Valley Mall  
**Time:** 9:00 AM - Noon  
**Cost:** Free to BCCAN agency members  
\$10.00 to non BCCAN agency members

### About the Program:

We are planning a three hour presentation focused on the information necessary to protect yourself and those around you if ever in an active shooter situation. The session will be a series of presentations that includes an explanation of when to shelter in place or to flee the area; when it occurs in a public building, your agency office or outside in an open environment.

Homeland Security will also talk about warning signs or vulnerability challenges to observe in your surroundings, along with viewing videos to observe an active shooters potential mannerisms.

A continental breakfast will be provided to allow participants a chance to network prior to the training.
