Domestic Violence Awareness Month

Mary Ann announced that October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month. She reports that 1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men experience DV in the US. Despite this prevalence she states that DV is an issue that people tend to not talk about. She passed out the "Put the Nail in It" flyer which asks folks to paint their ring fingernail purple to start the conversation. She then explained the empty place settings around the table with framed portraits. She states that these empty spaces represent people who have died because of DV. She also handed out a Power & Control wheel and explained that these components, not so much anger, are significant to DV. She states that the shelter has a variety of programs and presentations to help raise awareness and planning for DV situations. She states that agencies should have a plan in case a coworker is a victim of DV. She states that the WC also has advocates who can sit in on trails to offer support. And they have legal advocates who can assist with filing a PFA. They have staff who can sit with someone at the hospital if a rape kit needs to be completed. She explained that people who become victims of human trafficking often had prior DV or sexual abuse in their life. Mary Ann also stated that boys who witness DV are 3-4 times more likely to go on to abuse. She reminded everyone that the WC has to maintain confidentiality of the guests at all times. She states that their privacy is often the only thing some victims have left and the WC honors that. Dina asked when someone is referring a client even though the WC can't reveal information will they make note of the information and consider it in establishing eligibility. Mary Ann replied yes and stated that they appreciate the additional information. Mary Ann mentioned for folks to like their Facebook page found at: https://www.facebook.com/womenscenterbeavercounty/

Medicare and Retirement Specialist

Susan and Karen reported on the American Senior Benefits program. They are Medicare specialists who can work with seniors free of cost to understand their Medicare benefits (copays, premiums, coverage etc) and to make selections that best meet their unique needs. They can also screen for eligibility for other programs. They explained that open enrollment is Oct. 15 through Dec 7th and that their services are available during that time to help folks decide which plans best meet their needs. Dina also reminded everyone to always call the program to get an up to date census report.
