About the Training :

The training will provide the participants with a working knowledge of the principles of cultural competency and its relationship to diversity and inclusion. Special emphasis will be placed on the role that cultural competency plays in fostering positive communication and interaction with people/clients of different backgrounds including race, gender, sexual orientation, income, physical disability, religion, and other cultural demographics.

The goals are:

- To provide working knowledge of the cultural and cross cultural strategies supportive of positive interaction with others;
- To provide a working knowledge of the key concepts of Diversity, Inclusion and Cultural Competency;
- To foster an understanding of Cultural Competency as an “American/Global” skill;
- To increase their awareness of the link between ethnic identity and cultural competency predisposition;
- To foster an understanding of the barriers and supports for cultural competency in the workplace;
- To foster and understanding of how to reduce prejudice and make fair judgements about others.
